Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	1. The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 13 of which not more than 2 sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 for a classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension. The school is directed to run at least 01 section each of bal-vatika I, II & III in accordance with established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
2	Ramp at entrance is not properly seen in the IC video. School must ensure of availability of Ramp as per norms (ref CBSE Circular No 11/2024 dated 09/08/2024) at entrance and submit compliance on SARAS portal within 3 months.
3	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. The school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls as per norms of RPwD Act and Board's guidelines(ref CBSE Circular No 11/2024 dated 09/08/2024) within 03

	months and submit the compliance.
4	The school should replace plastic stools used in all the labs by wooden/metal stools. Physics lab does not have lab standard tables. The equipment are placed on wooden tables. The Biology lab is looking temporary arrangement and under stocked. Safety features, storage facility is not available in any of the lab. Physics lab should have lab standard permanent table and Biology lab should have a permanent workstation with inbuilt utilities. Sufficient washbasin needs to be installed in all the lab. Thus, the school is required to update the entire lab as per Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	Composite lab mandatory for secondary level is not seen in the video. The school must ensure of availability of Composite lab as per norms of the Board and submit compliance on SARAS Portal with videography within 3 months.
6	More Periodicals, Journals & newspapers should be added in the Library. Separate reading area for teachers are not seen in the library. Thus, the school is required to update the library as per Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The school has made a temporary arrangement for indoor sports in a small room without proper furniture. The school shall upgrade the indoor and outdoor sports facilities as per SoP issued by the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	Math lab is a temporary arrangement, with equipment is displayed on tables and no proper workstations / seating arrangements. No storage, Signage is seen. Thus, the school is required to update the lab as per Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
9	The urinals/pans need to have partitions. Hence the school is required to construct the same and submit compliance on SARAS portal.
10	Boundary wall from all the four side of the school Building is not seen in the video. School must ensure of availability of Boundary wall of prescribed height(6 ft) from all the four side of the school building and submit compliance on SARAS Portal with videography.
11	Scholl must ensure of appointment of sufficient teachers (PGT/TGT/PRT/NTT) as per norms of the Board and submit compliance on SARAS portal within 3 Months.
12	School shall ensure validity of all essential certificates/documents all the time, take action for renewal of mandatory certificates from time to time and upload under Mandatory Public Disclosure on its websites in all the times including NOC, Recognition/Land/Building Safety/Fire Safety/Society Registration/Water & Sanitation Certificate etc and submit compliance on SARAS Portal.
13	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Ajmer within 3 months and submit the compliance

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.

- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
